Rave Offline Installation Instructions (August 2007)

Thank you for downloading the Rave Offline. Rave Offline simulates the Rave console. The following are a set of instructions that should assist you installing the Rave Offline. Please read the instructions carefully and follow the suggested steps. Please read the release notes carefully to learn about the new features and bug fixes. If you encounter difficulties or have any questions, do not hesitate to contact us directly or via E-mail at: support@compulite.com

***If you have a previous version of the Rave Offline, please start from here:**

1. In case you have an earlier version of Rave Offline installed and running, close the Rave Offline by clicking the **X** in the upper right corner.
2. Save a copy of the "Shows" folder that is in the Rave folder if needed (*i.e: C:|Program files|Compulite|Rave offline editor|Shows*).
3. If you have created customized/New Devices, Back them up and store them to a different location so you can use them with the new version.
4. Follow step 14-17.
5. Optional - move the backup files back to the Rave Offline folder.

*** If you do not have a previous version of the Rave Offline, please start from here:**

6. Please Extract the "**OfflineSetup.zip**" into a folder and Run the installation by double-clicking the "**setup.exe**" file.
7. You will be prompt to a wizard. Click **Next**.
8. On the license agreement window select I agree and click **Next**.
9. On the customer information window click **Next**.
10. On the setup type window select **Complete** and click **Next**.
11. On the last window click **Install**.
12. Once the installation has completed click **Finish**.
13. Now you need to upgrade the installation to the latest SW version. To do so please continue following the steps below.

14. Extract the "**Offline_Upg_2.3 R3.zip**" into a different folder.
15. Copy the 2 files (**rave.exe** and **panel.exe**) into the folder that you installed your Rave Offline (**i.e: C: |Program files |Compulite |Rave offline editor**). A message that tells you that these files exist will appear. Select **YES TO ALL** to overwrite them.
16. Now you have a Rave Offline with the latest SW version.
17. You can start the Rave Offline by going to **START → PROGRAMS → RAVE OFFLINE EDITOR**, or by double- clicking on the shortcut "**RAVE OFFLINE EDITOR**" on your desktop.

Note: When running the Rave Offline for the first time, you might get a firewall message if to Block or unblock the application. Choose to Unblock and continue to work.

Now you are ready to experience the Rave Offline!
